

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

- 1. The name of the school is **Astley Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School**.
- The school is a VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOL.
- 3. The name of the governing body is **Astley Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School Governing Body**.
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. **Three p**arent governors
  - b. **One** Local Authority governor
  - c. One headteacher
  - d. **One** staff governor
  - e. **Eight** foundation governors.
- 5. The total number of governors is **14**.
- 6. **The Board of Education of the Diocese of Worcester** shall appoint 4 foundation governors.
  - The Trustees of the Free School Authority shall appoint 3 foundation governors.
- 7. [a] The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: The Principal Officiating Minister of St Peter's Church, Astley
  - [b] The Archdeacon of Dudley shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in [a] above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
- 8. **The Archdeacon of Dudley** shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.



## 9. The ethos statement of the school is:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 10. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015.
- 11. This instrument was made by order of Worcestershire County Council on 29 April 2015.
- 12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
